

## **Tenor Section Leader Opening**

St. John's Episcopal Church invites interested Tenors to audition for the position of paid Tenor Chorister & Section Leader, beginning in October, 2017 for the 2017-2018 choir season.

The Choir sings weekly from September through June and on Holy Days, including, but not limited to, Christmas Eve, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday Vigil, and two Evensongs during the choir season.

Section leads are expected to read music proficiently, be punctual to rehearsals and services, and be available for solo duties as necessary. Choir singers must be comfortable with the Episcopal Church liturgy, including all the “smells and bells” on solemn holy days.

St. John's parish supports fine classical/traditional choral music in superior performances within the framework of well-crafted worship services, where the integrity of music with word and sacrament is paramount. Choir members enjoy musical, spiritual and intellectual stimulation in a congenial atmosphere under experienced and good-humored leadership.

The choir of four paid section leaders plus volunteer singers rehearses weekly during the choir season at 9:00 AM on Sunday mornings, prior to the 10:30 Choral Eucharist. There are no mid-week rehearsals.

St. John's Church also is home to the finest pipe organ in Salem County, which is used regularly as a vehicle for musical prayers at the 10:30 a.m. service of Holy Eucharist.
